The Rho Beta Sigma Chapter of Phi Beta Sigma Fraternity, Inc., is one of several Alumni Chapters of the fraternity in the metro Atlanta area. Our aim is to support and service the needs of Gwinnett County through the pillars of our organization: Bigger and Better Business, Education, and Social Action. Under our Education program, we desire to give scholarships in the amount of \$1,914 to three graduating male Gwinnett County high school seniors in Spring 2023.

The winners will meet the following program guidelines:

- A record of volunteerism in the community through school and/or non-school sponsored activities
- Participation in at least one extracurricular school activity
- A minimum overall **GPA of 2.5** (unofficial transcript submission is required)
- Plans to attend a college/university or technical school
- Complete a 500 to 700 word essay answering the following prompt: "When you were a child, what did you want to be when you grew up? How has that dream evolved over time, and what factors have motivated those changes?"

The application deadline is **March 17**, **2023**. The recipients of the scholarships will be notified on **March 24**, **2023**.

The Rho Beta Sigma Chapter strongly suggests that each high school present this opportunity to the strongest applicants that match this program's guidelines.
